MICROSOFT SHAREPOINT FOUNDATION

- ▶ Download at no cost
- ▶ Companies using SharePoint Foundation must be licensed for Windows Server®

SERVICES

- ▶ To view content on Excel® Services, or Visio® Services the user must have SharePoint Server Standard and Enterprise CALs. To publish to Excel Services the user must be using Microsoft® Excel® obtained through Microsoft® Office Professional Plus. To publish to Visio Services the user must be using Microsoft® Visio® Professional or Microsoft® Visio® Premium 2010
- ▶ PowerPivot® for SharePoint requires SQL Server 2012 Enterprise, SQL Server 2012 BI, or SQL Server 2008 R2 Enterprise. To use PowerPivot for Excel, the user must download the add-in for Excel 2010 and have SharePoint Server Standard and Enterprise CALs

VIRTUALISATION

A SharePoint Server licence allows one physical or virtual instance.

LICENSING SHAREPOINT SERVER

Purchase a Microsoft® SharePoint® Server licence for each server and CALs for either users or devices.

STANDARD and ENTERPRISE CALS

Microsoft SharePoint Server 2010 offers different levels of functionality, and there are CALs which correspond to this.

The core functionality (depicted by the blue shading) is linked to a Standard CAL (depicted by the blue licence) assigned to a user or device.

If the extended functionality (depicted by the red shading) is utilised, then the purchase of an Enterprise CAL is required (depicted by the red licence) in addition to the Standard CAL.

Note that it is hard to be compliant with users with a mixture of Standard and Enterprise CALs on the same server farm.

SHAREPOINT SERVER FOR INTERNET SITES (Standard or Enterprise)

Either a Standard or Enterprise edition licence is required for each external facing server and no CALs are required for the external users.

Note that this licence is for external users only. Internal users can use this licence if all content is accessible to external users. If the server has items for internal use only, CALs and SharePoint Server licences are required as above.

FAST SEARCH SERVER FOR SHAREPOINT

- ▶ Purchase a Microsoft® FAST Search Server for SharePoint licence for each server
- ▶ SharePoint Server Standard and Enterprise CALs are required

SEARCH SERVER

- ▶ Purchase a Microsoft® Search Server licence for each server
- ▶ No CALs are required

SEARCH SERVER EXPRESS

- ▶ Download at no cost

RELATED TECHNOLOGIES

- ▶ Microsoft® SQL Server is an infrastructure requirement for SharePoint Server
- ▶ Microsoft® SharePoint® Designer is for development of SharePoint sites including workflow and is free of charge
- ▶ Microsoft® SharePoint® Workspace is included with Microsoft Office 2010 Professional Plus and provides offline access to SharePoint content
